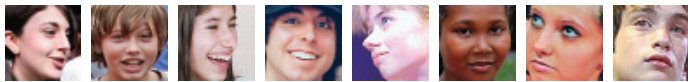

YEAR I EXPLORATION	<p>First year students explore the world of storytelling, movement, vocalization and character development with an emphasis on ensemble work. Choose from class times below.</p> <p>GRADES 3 AND 4 Tuesdays 4 - 6 pm Wednesdays 4 - 6 pm Thursdays 4 - 6 pm Saturdays 9 - 11 am</p> <p>GRADES 5 AND 6 Wednesdays 4 - 6 pm Thursdays 4 - 6 pm Saturdays 9 - 11 am</p>	<p>In their first year, students explore movement, vocalization, character development and ensemble building. Through workshop exercises, they begin to develop acting skills needed to create truthful characters. Choose from times below.</p> <p>GRADES 7 - 8 Saturdays 9 - 11 am, 11 am - 1 pm GRADES 7 - 9 Wednesdays 4 - 6 pm GRADES 9 - 12 Saturdays 11 am - 1 pm or 1 - 3 pm</p>	YEAR I TOOLS OF ACTING
YEAR II DEVELOPMENT	<p>Second year students refine skills and move on to mime, improvisation, enhanced vocal work and beginning dramatic play development. Prerequisite: Year I. Choose from class times below.</p> <p>GRADES 4 - 6 Tuesdays 4 - 6 pm Thursdays 4 - 6 pm Saturdays 9 - 11 am</p>	<p>Second year students deepen their skills and delve more thoroughly into character development and script analysis, with emphasis on creating acting objectives and sharing scenes through character relationships. Choose from class times below.</p> <p>GRADES 7 - 9 Thursdays 4 - 6 pm GRADES 7 - 8 Saturdays 9 - 11 am or 11 am - 1 pm GRADES 9 - 12 Saturdays 11 am - 1 pm or 1 - 3 pm</p>	YEAR II TRUTH IN ACTING
YEAR III ADVANCED TRAINING	<p>Body and voice are the actor's tools. In the third year, students use these tools to further develop their technique through mask work, movement, voice and improvisation. The class culminates in a spring performance project. Prerequisite: Year II.</p> <p>YOUTH ENSEMBLE GRADES 5 AND 6 Tuesdays 4 - 6 pm</p> <p>JR. ENSEMBLE GRADES 6 - 8 Saturdays 9 - 11 am</p>	<p>Teens who have completed 2 years or more in the Conservatory may select below.</p> <p>IMPROVISATION: Theatre games and character work for those who participate in competitive improvisation. Saturdays 11 am - 1 pm</p> <p>TEEN ENSEMBLE: As serious students advance, they continue to explore characterization, emotional truth and availability, active pursuit of an objective and ensemble storytelling. This important class for honing skills and taking greater risks culminates in a spring performance project. Saturdays 1 - 3 pm</p> <p>MUSICAL THEATRE FOR THE ACTOR*: This exciting class prepares the actor for audition and performance. Students learn what it means to act a song and sing a scene, with emphasis on music and text interpretation, healthy use of voice, selection of material and audition techniques. GRADES 9 - 12 Saturdays 11 am - 1 pm</p> <p><small>*There is a supplemental accompanist and materials fee for Musical Theatre of \$40 per 10 week session</small></p>	YEAR III ADVANCED TRAINING
JUNIOR PLAYERS PERFORM	<p>GRADES 6, 7 AND 8. Serious acting students may audition for the advanced ensemble group which presents a full production of a professionally written play in the Nicholas Studio. Additional rehearsal time may be required in the spring. Classes meet twice weekly.</p> <p>THIS IS A YEAR LONG COMMITMENT. Prerequisite: completion of Year II. Audition Required. Tuesdays 4 - 6 pm and Saturdays 9 - 11 am</p>	<p>GRADES 9, 10, 11 AND 12. The most advanced theatre training for serious and committed students culminates in a full production of a professionally written play in the Nicholas Studio. Additional rehearsal time may be required in the spring. Classes meet twice weekly.</p> <p>THIS IS A YEAR LONG COMMITMENT. Prerequisite: completion of Teen Year II. Audition Required.
