ABOUT THE PRODUCTION

ABOUT THE ROLE

SCR seeks a Hair and Makeup Run Crew member to join the production team. A great fit for this role means you have previous experience as a wig technician, make up artist, and/or dresser in a theatrical environment.

Daily activities and responsibilities may include:

- Assist actors with putting on wigs and/or makeup and assisting with quick changes
- Participate in the maintenance and upkeep of wigs throughout the run
- Participate in dressing room load in and strike
- Safely maintain wig and makeup work spaces, storage spaces, and inventory to a high standard of cleanliness and organization
- Communicate show progress and issues to the Hair and Makeup Supervisor and Assistant
- Maintain productive and positive communication and teamwork backstage with cast and crew
- Assist other departments with backstage running functions as requested by Hair and Makeup Supervisor and stage management

ABOUT THE PERSON

Qualities and skills that best serve a Hair and Makeup Run Crew Member may be:

- Professional or academic experience acting as a wig technician and/or dresser in a theatrical environment
- Experience working in a professional wig and makeup shop environment or equivalent
- Makeup effect and appliance creation skills highly desired
- Interest in learning new wig and makeup application and maintenance techniques
- Commitment to equity, diversity, inclusion and belonging, and enthusiasm to nurture an anti-racist work culture

WORKING CONDITION

Regular tasks of this position may include:

- Standing for 2-3 hours at a time
- Seeing and maneuvering in crowded and dark backstage spaces
- Occasionally performing quick changes or hand-offs on staircases
- Theatrical haze or fog commonly used onstage and backstage
