PAYMENT

- Payment due at time of reservation.
- Payment plan options for non-profit organizations are available upon request.
 - 50% Deposit due at time of reservation; final installment is due one month prior to your performance date.
- Orders placed less than 30 days before a performance must be paid in full at the time of reservation.

Note: If a change to your order occurs and a deposit has been paid, an adjustment to the final payment will reflect the added or subtracted seats. Payments toward your order are non-refundable. Tickets are non-exchangeable.

TICKET DELIVERY

- If you would like your tickets mailed, please request a ticket manifest, which will list the row and number of each seat. Once you have completed the ticket manifest by assigning each student to a seat and have returned it to the theatre, your tickets will be mailed to you. This will allow the Box Office to reprint any lost tickets on the day of the performance.
- Physical tickets will not be issued for student matinee performances.

SEATING

- Student matinees are general admission seating. Your group will be seated upon arrival at the theater.
- For public performances, the student discount is available for Sections A & B; all seating is subject to availability.
- Each theatregoer must have a ticket, including children.

SPECIAL NEEDS

- Please advise us if any members of your group have special needs—including difficulty navigating stairs, use of wheelchairs, or walkers or certified service animal assistance—at the time you place your reservation.
